### **Membership News - Spring 2025**

What does it mean to be a member of the Mashpee Women's Club? We currently have 272 members including 52 new members. As a club, our focuses have included donating to multiple charitable causes, traveling to Italy, enjoying new member coffees, participating in book clubs, attending monthly luncheons with an array of interesting programs and informational speakers, going bowling, playing MahJongg, an annual golf event, and other interesting activities open to members.

To be able to provide all of these wonderful opportunities, we would like to update you on the annual membership renewal process.

Our membership year runs from September through August. Renewal time is July and August - regardless of when a member joins during the fiscal year. For example, if a new member joined in August, November, or June, the member still needs to renew in the July/August timeframe. Due to the low cost of dues, we can't make exceptions. **Please note, dues need to be paid in full by August 31st.** We strongly encourage Venmo payments in July or August. We will be at July and August luncheons to collect checks from anyone who prefers to pay by check. Unfortunately, if members do not pay by August 31st, we will be assessing a \$10 late charge.

## **MEMBERSHIP LUNCHEONS**

MWC Luncheon reservations are **finalized** on the 2nd Monday of the month – one week prior to the luncheon. Checks, **payable to Mashpee Women's Club**, (P.O. Box 1613, Mashpee, MA 02649) must be received in the Mashpee Women's Club post office box **no later than** the 2nd Monday of the month by 12:00 Noon. If your check is going to be late please contact Cindy Collins that your check is in the mail; otherwise, you will NOT be included in the headcount. If paying by Venmo, your payment must be made no later than that 2nd Monday by 12:00 Noon. Payments received after the 12:00 Noon deadline will NOT be included in the count if you have not previously contacted Cindy Collins via email at [cindyscollins@comcast.net](mailto:cindyscollins@comcast.net) or by phone at **508-359-4900**.

New Seabury requires the final count by 12:30 p.m. on the 2nd Monday of the month to accommodate our members. The Chef at New Seabury has an ordering deadline and preparation times, as well as needs time to arrange for adequate staffing required for service.

If you have any dietary concerns or simply prefer the vegetarian option on any given month, please be sure to advise Cindy in advance of the luncheon to ensure your request.
